- **Via Germagnano 48/A** from Monday to Saturday 7:15 am - 7 pm
- **Via Gorini 20/A** from Monday to Saturday 7:15 am - 7 pm
- **Via Ravina 19/A** from Monday to Saturday 7:15 am - 6:30 pm, Sunday and holidays* 7:30 am - 1 pm

This facility also **houses a teaching workshop dedicated to environmental issues and a craftsman's workshop** where small unused items are recovered and then sold on in the indoor market, which is open to the public on the following days at the following times:

 - **Friday, 10 am - 1 pm and 3:30 - 6:30 pm;**
 - **Saturday, 9:30 am - 1 pm and 2:30 - 6:30 pm.**

What you can take there

- second-hand clothes, shoes and accessories
- paper and cardboard, plastic packaging, glass
- electric and electronic toys
- bulky waste (furniture, mattresses and bedsteads, armchairs...)
- halogen, fluorescent light bulbs, neon lamps
- wood (crates, platforms...)
- small quantities of rubble
- ferrous materials and metals
- used spectacles
- used cooking oils and mineral oils from cars
- and motorbikes
- tyres (4 maximum)
- WEEE (waste electrical and electronic equipment)
- hazardous waste
- sanitary fixtures, ceramics, fillers, upholstery, small quantities of wooden or iron hand-crafted products
- small quantities of cuttings and clippings from private gardens
- bottle corks
- toners and consumables for fax machines, printers and photocopiers

* With the exception of New Year's Day, Easter, May Day, Assumption Day and Christmas

Boosting services in the San Salvario district

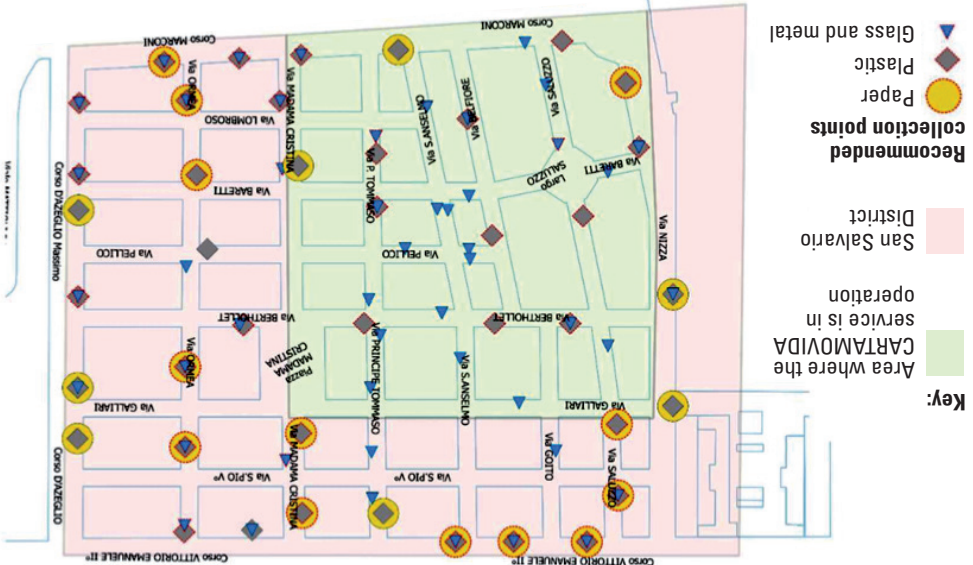
Area stretching between Corso Vittorio Emanuele II, Corso Massimo D'Azeglio, Corso Marconi and Via Nizza

For all small waste electrical and electronic equipment (RAE), visit www.amiat.it for the list of stores taking part in the "uno contro zero" (one for none) collection scheme, by providing a bin, supplied by Amiat, dedicated to the disposal of such waste without any obligation to buy.

Let's get separate collection of waste rolling



- **More ecological islands** with all the differentiated waste collection bins
- **More bins** to collect paper and cardboard, plastic packaging
- **A larger quantity of big bins and the elimination of smaller bins** to collect glass and metal packaging
- **More extensive monitoring** across the territory
- **New CARTAMOVIDA service** for cardboard collection (read inside the leaflet)

NON-RECYCLABLE WASTE: this is the bin to use for all residue from other waste types which cannot be recycled in any other way

ORGANIC WASTE:
1. should ALWAYS be disposed of in a food waste bin liner
2. do not throw away pet excrement or non-compostable litter
3. food should be disposed of without packaging

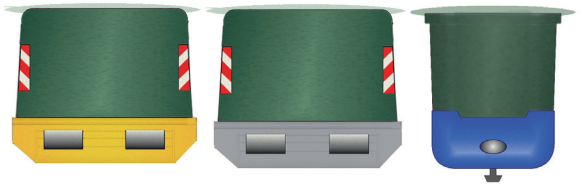
GLASS AND METAL PACKAGING:
1. dispose of loose, without bags
2. you can throw away tins, but also all metal packaging (cans, tin foil, aluminium containers and trays)
3. DO NOT DISPOSE OF: mirrors, window panes, plates, cups, ceramic, pans, light bulbs

PLASTIC PACKAGING:
1. only dispose of the packaging (bottles, packets, polystyrene, cellophane...), in other words the plastic materials that contain or wrap another product, including clean plastic cups and plates and plastic clothes hangers
2. DO NOT THROW AWAY plastic objects (toothbrushes, toys, plastic cutlery, pieces of hard plastic should be disposed of in the non-recyclable waste bin)
3. DON'T GET CONFUSED: the new biodegradable bags should not be thrown away in this bin! Use them for organic waste

PAPER AND CARDBOARD:
1. dispose of loose, without bags
2. we often consider materials that aren't actually paper as "paper": for instance, greaseproof paper, carbon paper, "sweet wrappers", "ice-cream wrappers", "pastry papers". Genuine paper is the paper we all know (the paper used for books or newspapers, for instance)... don't get confused!
3. It is strictly forbidden to leave cartons beside the bins, even if properly folded. Where in operation in your area, use the Cartasio, Cartacinesca or Cartamovida services. Alternatively, fold up the cartons or tear them up into small pieces and dispose of them in the dedicated bin.

Read these few tips to avoid certain mistakes which would render separate collection of waste pointless.

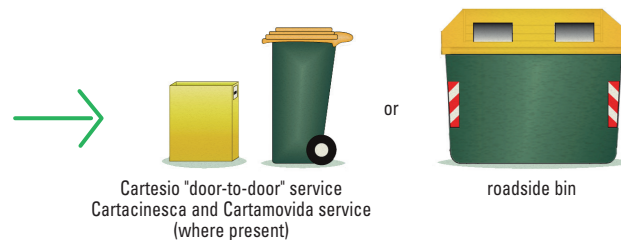


How separate collection of waste works



Paper and cardboard

Newspapers, books, exercise books, folded cartons, packaging and cardboard boxes, paper bags, cardboard cases and strips, corrugated cardboard packaging and paper advertisements. In addition, **milk and drinks cartons** (before disposal, we recommend you rinse them to avoid unpleasant odours forming).



Dispose of loose, do not use bags



As a priority, use the Cartesio service and/or, where present, Cartacinesca/Cartamovida. If you use the roadside collection service, remember **that it is strictly forbidden to place cartons, even if folded properly, next to the bins**. Fold them or tear them up into smaller pieces and place them in the dedicated bin



Glass and metal packaging

Bottles, glasses, glass pots and vases, clean aluminium tins, trays, pods, tubes and caps, metal food containers (for pulses, jams, tuna, pet food), metal crown caps, aluminium food packaging, steel boxes (before disposal, we recommend you rinse the packaging to avoid unpleasant odours forming).



Dispose of loose, do not use bags



Plastic packaging

Plastic bottles (before disposal, we recommend you rinse the packaging to avoid unpleasant odours forming, then crush them), detergent bottles, clean plastic containers. Also polystyrene, bags, film wrap, cellophane packaging for magazines and products, clean cups and plates.

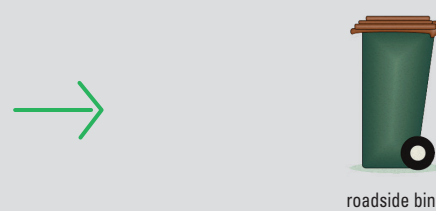


Dispose of loose and do not use biodegradable shoppers. Do not dispose of plastic items that are not packaging (e.g. cutlery, toys).

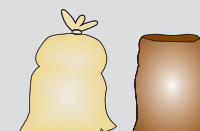


Organic waste

Organic kitchen waste, leftover food, egg shells, coffee grounds and tea bags, cut flowers, stale bread, kitchen roll and tissues, small quantities of **compostable** animal litter.



Dispose of in a compostable liner. Do not use plastic liners.



Non-recyclable waste

Plastic, rubber and ceramic objects, dirty paper, broken toys, synthetic sponges, nappies, sanitary pads, non-compostable animal litter, plastic cutlery and, in general, everything that cannot be disposed of in the other bins.

Other types of waste



Bulky waste

Furniture, chairs, mattresses, bedsteads, demijohns and large drums, sofas and armchairs.

WEEE

(waste electrical and electronic equipment)

Refrigerators, air conditioners, washing machines, dishwashers, televisions, computer monitors, ovens, all small household appliances in general, battery-operated electrical or electronic toys, LED or halogen light bulbs, neon lights.

- **at collection centres** (see overleaf) or **free collection by calling** the Environmental Customer Care Service (for large-sized items)
- **at any retailer** when you purchase a new item of the same type
- **at major retailers** (over 400 m² sales surface area) without any obligation to buy, only for small-sized WEEE (less than 25 cm)



Hazardous waste

Batteries, expired medication, printer toners, paint pots.

- **at collection centres** (see overleaf)
- **in the dedicated bins (for batteries and medication)** placed outside stores and chemist's offering this collection service



Used vegetable oils

Vegetable oil used for food preservation (such as the oil in tins of tuna or jars of vegetables in oil), used cooking and frying oil.

Grass cutting and branches

Grass cuttings, flowers, branches, tree and hedge clippings, vegetable garden weeding residue.

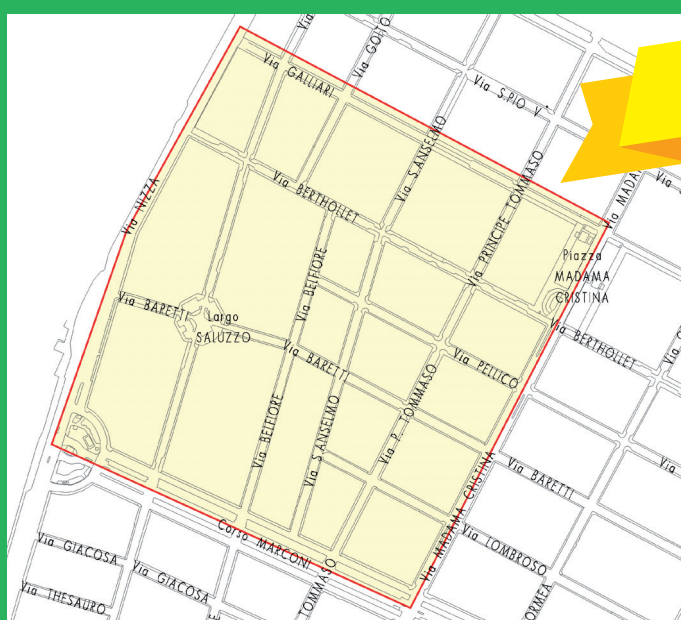

Second-hand clothes, shoes and accessories

Clothing and shoes in good condition, clean and folded, bags, belts, miscellaneous accessories.

NEW

“CARTAMOVIDA” cardboard collection service

WHAT IS IT?

From 16th April 2018, properly folded cartons can be left on the pavement in front of your home or business for "door-to-door" collection.

WHO CAN USE IT?

All families and businesses inside the area stretching from **Via Galliani on the odd and even numbers sides, Via Nizza on the odd numbers side, Via Marconi on the odd numbers side, to Via Madama Cristina on the even numbers side** (see map).

HOW AND WHEN?

Every **Monday, Wednesday and Friday between 4:30 pm and 5:30 pm**, except on mid-week holidays, users can leave properly folded cartons on the pavement outside their home or business. Amiat will collect them in the hours that immediately follow.

SERVICES IN OPERATION

In addition to CARTAMOVIDA, the following services remain in operation, respectively: **Cartacinesca** only for the businesses in Via Nizza and Via Madama Cristina, and **Cartesio** for all domestic and non-domestic users. However, all users can continue to dispose of paper and cardboard, properly folded or torn up into smaller pieces, in the dedicated roadside bins.
